August is Sturgis month for many motorcyclists, South  
kota has motorcycles for as far as the eye can see.  
no different for my husband Wayne and myself. This trip was was definitely an  
adventure for us for many reasons. Left on Sunday August 7th bright and early,  
made it to Columbia Missouri first night right on schedule. Left the hotel early  
Monday morning, about 90 miles in Wayne realizes he left something VERY im-  
portant back at the hotel we just left. Turn around and go back and they had  
it tucked away in the back office, get it and we're off again. We make it to  
Iowa, mile marker 71 to be exact when the clutch goes out on the bike and  
we're stuck on the side of the road, two young local kids stop on their bikes and  
try to help. There is only one tow company in that area for miles. Geico can't  
find a tow company that will tow a motorcycle and told us to find one and  
they'll reimburse us. For 5 hours we waited and not one tow company would  
get us back to Omaha Nebraska to Dillon Brothers Motorsports to get the bike  
fixed. We lucked out when the first tow company called and said he had a  
friend who just started his own company and would come and tow us. It's dark  
in Iowa at night, very dark. He finally made it around 11 o'clock and got us to  
the dealership and we dropped the bike off. He took us to the nearest hotel  
who actually didn't have any rooms, the night clerk found us a room and they  
extended our check out time so we could get the bike settled and get a rental  
car, since no one rents motorcycles in the area anymore. The rental car com-  
pany was out of cars but had one SUV in the back that needed detailing, (we  
ordered a compact) no problem, he gave it to us for the same price. Off we  
go, made it to the MRF Induction on Tuesday, saw Sturgis in a car, very strange  
feeling, had a ball and hung out with good friends from all the ABATE's around  
the country. Dillon Brothers didn't disappoint, bike was ready on Saturday morn-  
ing for pickup at half the cost of what we thought. A bad situation turned out to  
be a blessing in many ways, from the two young guys who stayed with us for al-  
most 2 hours, the tow guy with his pickup truck and flatbed, the hotel that was  
booked and gave us someone else's room, extended our time and Dillon Broth-  
ers who expedited the clutch parts so we could get home. We couldn't be  
more thankful...to be continued next month....

## Motorcycle Riders Foundation inducted into the Sturgis Museum & Hall of Fame

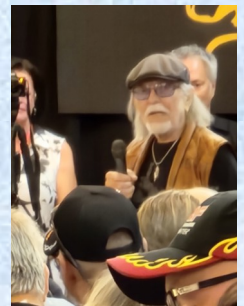
The Motorcycle Riders Foundation was inducted into the Sturgis Motorcycle Museum & Hall of Fame at the breakfast in Deadwood on Wednesday August 10th. The MRF President and Chairman of the Board Kirk 'Hardtail' Willard had this to say, "On behalf of the original Steering committee, the Board of Directors, all Sustaining Motorcycle Rights Organizations, MRF State Representatives, and general members, we appreciate the Sturgis Motorcycle Museum and Hall of fame recognizing the MRF for their tireless dedication to protecting the members rights and freedoms for nearly four decades."

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation is a national organization dedicated to lobbying for those who ride, to protecting and defending their rights as motorcyclists, and to addressing the concerns of street riders and the motorcycle industry they support. In 1985 the MRF held its first annual Meeting of the Minds conference. For many activists from around the country this marked the first time they'd met to discuss how to best preserve and protect motorcycling. The main issues of the day, mandatory helmet laws, unfair insurance laws, and the right to modify motorcycles, are still faced today, along with many others. In 2022, the MRF will hold its 38th Annual Meeting of the Minds, representing an unbroken chain of unparalleled training and networking opportunities that has molded the American biker's rights movement into the highly effective force it is today. MRF also holds its annual 'Bikers Inside the Beltway' grassroots lobbying event where riders from all over the country go to Washington, D.C. to help fight for their rights.
