




## The GENA McLEOD MEMORIAL RIDE

#### From the Road

I ended up in a total "ground hog day" fiasco due to some construction and an uncooperative GPS, but made the meeting spot about 3 minutes before the No. Ga. riders arrived. We hit some pretty torrential rain about 60 miles east of Slidell and had to sit out the storm for a bit. All in all, it was a good weekend, and fun was had by all.

I attended the District 11 monthly meeting for September. It was very productive and details will be forthcoming in future newsletters. They had their nominations and it was announced that I've got a new set of responsibilities at the state level, as Assistant to the Southern District Representative. It sounds so important eh.

Finally, I'm gearing up to head to Des Moines, Iowa for this year's MRF Meeting of the Minds. I've been asked, and agreed to participate in a panel discussion with several other women to discuss issues related to being a woman in the world of motorcycles and political action. It'll be pretty exciting and I'll provide an update when it's over for next month.

## We Told You So...

August 26, 2022

At last year's MRF Meeting of the Minds in Atlanta, Georgia the fate of the internal combustion engine was discussed. In fact, at the urging of ABATE of Illinois, the following language was added to the MRF's 2022 Legislative Priorities: "Work to ensure the survival of combustion engines. Including elimination of the California air quality waivers which threaten combustion engine production."

In October of 2021 California Governor Gavin Newson signed a bill into law banning the sale of all off-road, gas-powered engines, including generators, lawn equipment, pressure washers, chainsaws, weed trimmers, and even golf carts. And less than one year later we learn this, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) that governs motor vehicle emissions for the state adopted new rules that will require 35% of the new cars sold in the state are electric or plug-in hybrids by 2026, with that percentage rising to 68% by 2030 and 100% by 2035.

That's right gas burning cars will no longer be for sale in the country's largest state in less than 15 years. Other states, including Massachusetts and Washington have already signaled that they would follow California's lead.

What does the future of motorcycling look like?

Will the bike you are riding today be legal in a few years?

What will your kids or grandkids be riding... or will they even be allowed to own a motorcycle?

Your Freedom is under assault and without your help we can't fight back! Thank you to all the members of the Motorcycle Riders Foundation for defending your Freedoms.
