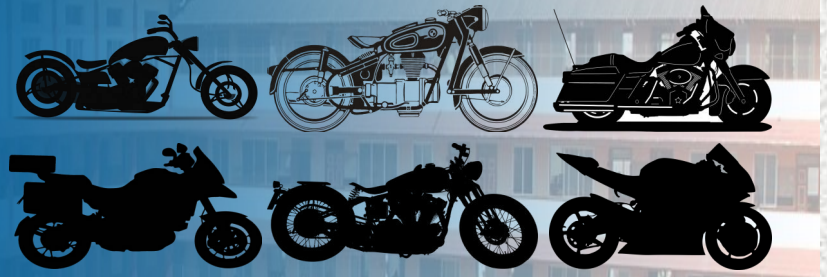

LEGISLATIVE NEWS



ABATE of Georgia Legislative Update:

Things are moving at the Gold Dome in Atlanta. House and Senate are sending bills to committee and then to the hopper.

At this time, we have two specific bills we are working on, HB 119 and SB 71.

HB 119 has gotten a favorable response so far in the House. It addresses an All Vehicle move over law, so that any vehicle on the shoulder needs to be given the extra space previously only allotted to emergency vehicles, LE, etc. this is a really good idea, since our motorcycles can really be invisible on the sides of the highways and byways. We have an email template than can be used to encourage your district legislator, and others to continue to support this bill.

SB 71 is a solution looking for a problem. It is looking to set age 16 as the mandatory minimum age for a motorcycle passenger. There is no information available yet, to explain who thought this was a good idea. We are against passage of this bill. We have a template for this as well to express our displeasure at the idea of this arbitrary age restriction for passengers. The day I'm writing this article, I saw a small person make a small motorcycle look big and they were a grown adult. So, I'm pretty sure this bill is not about the size of passengers.

I know I told you we had a sponsor for the "Dead Red" bill, and despite the commitment, the representative has not followed through. We continue to email and text him to get that bill moving.

We will be using the Facebook Members and Friends page to publish legislative actions we are working on. We welcome everyone to assist us in keeping eyes on the Georgia General Assembly.

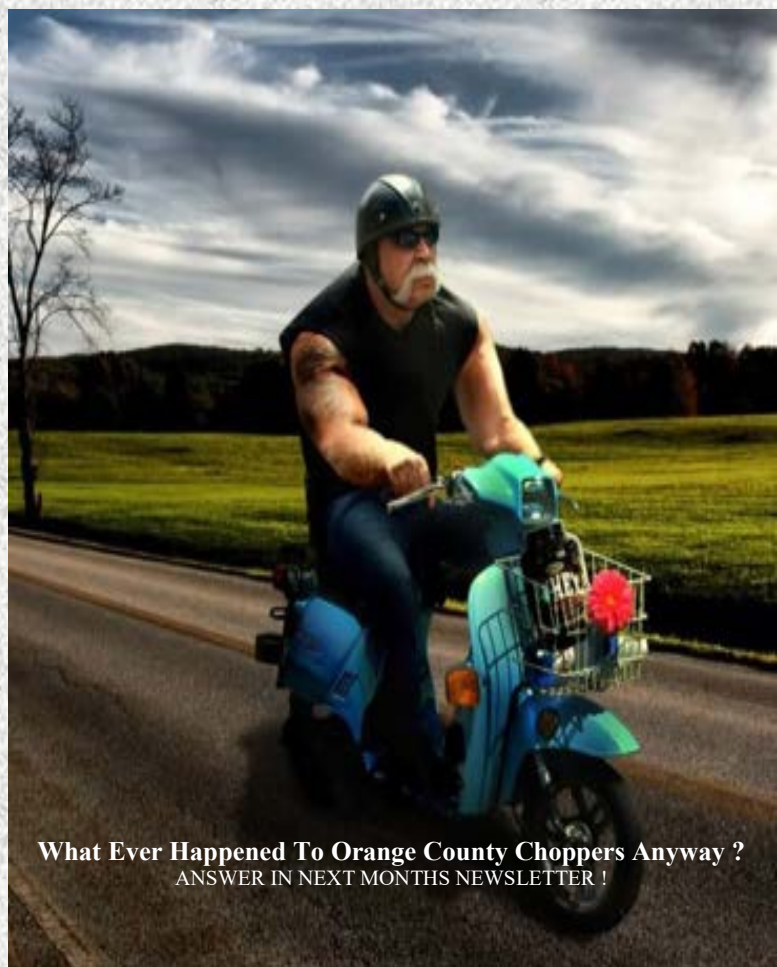


The One Minute EDUCATOR

With the new riding season upon us, there will be a lot of group rides. I would like to take a minute to mention a few things that I've learned over the past 20 plus years of group rides:

- Always ride staggered (this will allow the riders some room to avoid hazards in the road)
- Maintain your position (this will provide predictability in the event of a road hazard)
- Avoid "rubber banding" (not only an annoyance to others but does not provide predictability)
- Use hand signals (to communicate road hazards, the need to speed up or slow down, etc)
- No show offs! (avoid the urge to overuse that throttle....the accordion effect is dangerous to all)

Group rides are a lot of fun! Be safe and enjoy the ride!

In Memoriam

Ralph Wayne Snyder, Sr.

Oct 21, 1938 - Jan 20, 2023

Mr. Ralph Wayne Snyder, Sr, 84, of Grantville, GA passed away Friday, January 20, 2023 at Christian City Rehabilitation Center. He was born October 21, 1938 in South Bend, IN to the late Rolland & Elizabeth Snyder. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by wife, Sharon Anne Snyder.

Ralph grew up in Highland, IN, & after graduating high school, enlisted in the U.S. Navy from December 1956 through September, 1959, where he achieved Sargent-of-arms, Jr. police. He went on to further his Naval career in the U.S Navy Reserve through February 1962. He met Sharon during his time in the Navy Reserve, & they were married in November 1960. After an Honorable Discharge from the Armed Services, he worked for Patten Industries as a heavy equipment mechanic. He moved his family to Georgia in 1982, after accepting a position at Trax Industries. In 1991, Ralph became involved with A.B.A.T.E. of Georgia & Ride For Kids, using his abilities to assist those in need. After his full retirement in 1999, he dedicated most of his time to his Biker Ministry, joining the Christian Motorcycle Association, becoming an Ordained Minister, & preaching the Gospel to bikers, prison inmates, & those in his community.
