LEGISLATIVE

Welcome Back ALEX!



Hello fellow 'ABATEers'! I am back – to a degree. Still recovering from the accident of 8/28/24. I am still wheelchair bound, and I have more surgeries to go, but I am recovering. I'll get there! I have now been described as a “poster-child” for motorcycle safety.

The driver that hit me was not paying attention to where he was going. During my hospital stay of a full month, and in the subsequent months thereafter, I have been attempting to communicate with our legislators. This has proven difficult, and my update is limited due to that fact.

I finally heard from my Representative, Solomon Adesanya (who was formerly very helpful) on January 28th, and I visited the Capitol on Jan 30th. I was disappointed to learn our bills had not been filed yet; I knew they would not merit pre-filing, as I learned that last session. As of the writing of this article, the Anti-profiling bill has been filed, however I do not yet have that number (as of 2/6). The other bill we plan to endorse, the “Motorcycle Mobility Safety Act”, or Dead-Red bill, has not yet been filed.

I met with my Representative briefly during my visit, but it was a very busy day, including press conferences, and Governor Kemp's speech.

I am continuing to press my Representative to keep me informed. We were supposed to meet in Marietta on the evening of Feb 1st, but he was a no-show. We spoke briefly on the evening of Feb 5, and I informed him I plan to meet with the Motor Vehicle Committee at the Capitol to inform them of our intentions, and to help provide accurate information regarding these and upcoming bills. I will continue my efforts, including the beginning of the conversation about lane filtering.

One other important item to note: ABATE of Georgia currently does not have a lobbyist at the Capitol; Daisha has taken another position and can no longer be of assistance. I have received some information from her regarding the position, and how to go about getting a new lobbyist. This position will require significant knowledge of Bill-writing as well as the understanding of the Legislative process.

Lastly, I hope to communicate with the Federal Highway Administration and State Highway Authorities to find out if ABATE can partner with them for a promotion during “Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month” in May. Partnering will likely mean financial involvement, and if that is necessary, it will of course be arranged through the ABATE Board of Directors.

GEORGIA

MOTORCYCLE HISTORY



In 1909, the Atlanta Speedway hosted the first professional motorcycle races in Georgia. The 2-mile clay track was built to compete with the Indianapolis Speedway.

Opening day of the Atlanta Speedway was Tuesday November 9, 1909 and was the event of the year. Thousands of spectators jammed the stands and, according to this article, seven world records were broken! Baseball legend Ty Cobb timed the races. The opening event was held in conjunction with the Atlanta Car Show. The first professional motorcycle races in Atlanta were held at the Atlanta Speedway on November 11, 1909. The races were part of a week-long celebration that included the Atlanta Auto Show.

Race details

- The races were held over two days, with separate races for amateurs and professionals
- The professional race had five competitors: R.W. Gayle, Gail Joyce, and Bob Stubbs on Indians, Russell Walthour on a Merkel, and V. Moss on a Reading Standard

Track details

- The Atlanta Speedway was a two-mile clay track built in 1909 to compete with the Indianapolis Speedway
- The track's surface was clay, sand, and gravel with asphalt binder

The track had a grandstand that could seat 25,000 and bleachers that could seat 15,000

Other details

- Baseball legend Ty Cobb timed the races
- The opening day of the Atlanta Speedway was Tuesday, November 9, 1909
- The track was designed by Jack Prince and financed by Asa Candler, the founder of Coca-Cola



This week, the Motorcycle Riders Foundation participated in a reception for the Congressional Motorcycle Caucus. The event played host to several lawmakers, including the Co-Chairs of the House Motorcycle Caucus: Rep. Tim Walberg (Michigan), Rep. Troy Balderson (Ohio) and Rep. Derrick Van Orden (Wisconsin). The Chair of the Senate Motorcycle Caucus, Senator Gary Peters (Michigan) also attended. Additional legislators present included newly elected Representatives Dave Taylor (Ohio) and John McGuire (Virginia).

These two caucuses are made of legislators from both parties who have an interest in supporting motorcyclists and the motorcycling lifestyle. The event also included several Capitol Hill staffers and other motorcycling groups, including the American Motorcyclist Association, Harley-Davidson Motor Company and the Motorcycle Industry Council.

Growing these motorcycle-focused organizations is a priority for the Motorcycle

Riders Foundation. Events like this one and the annual "Ride to Work Day" on Capitol Hill are great ways to connect with elected officials and their staff in a less formal setting and build relationships that can help impact our legislative agenda.
