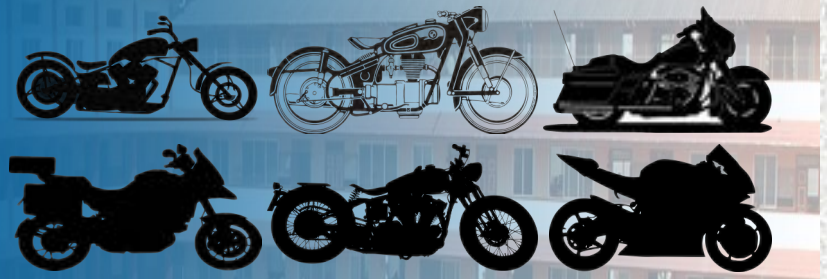

FROM THE STATE DIRECTOR



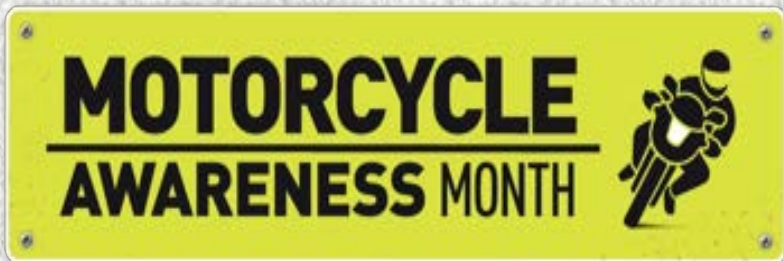

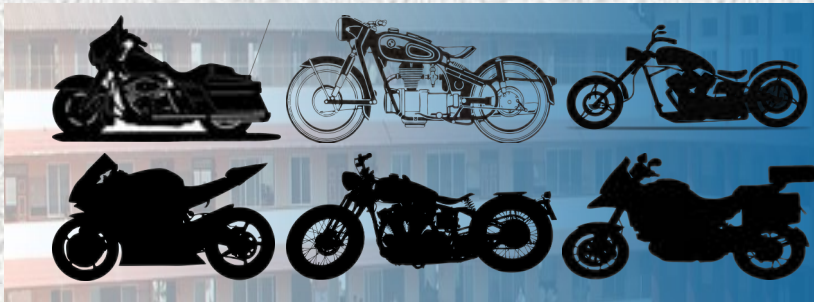

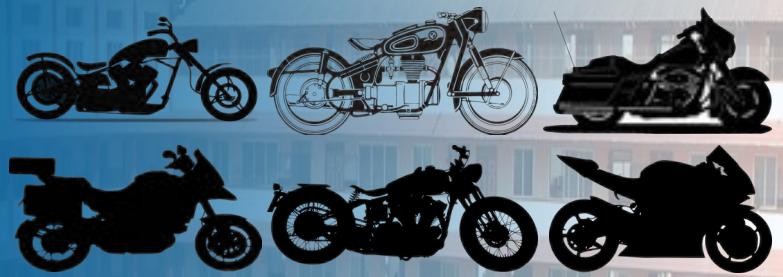
MAY is Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month! While I'm sure all the readers here already know this, it is still important to spread the word, especially to non-bikers! One great idea that's been around for awhile is to have drivers with children play the motorcycle game during car rides: much like the old "punch-bug" games of the past, have kids spot and count motorcycles they see; it can even be made more complex (for older kids) to get one point for cruisers, two points for sport bikes, three for adventure bikes, etc. If children get used to looking for motorcycles

when they're young, they will be more likely to spot bikes when they become old enough to drive; it'll build smart habits in how they look out for others on the road. Food for thought. Speaking of Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month, I petitioned (requested, actually) Governor Kemp to make his usual Proclamation to declare May as such, and the Proclamation is included here in my report. Please note: I am not single-handedly responsible for this; Governor Kemp makes such a proclamation every year, but it's important to remind him that we expect this to happen.

To the legislative side: as reported last month, the two bills we are most "attached" to (our bill: Anti-profiling, and the Motorcycle Mobility Safety Act, or Dead-red bill) did not make it to the House floor this session. We will bring them back next session (Jan. 2026) and with any luck they may be heard. If that becomes the case, I will provide talking points and information regarding how you can contact your Representatives to have your voice heard. Also, carrying-over from my last report, I did make an effort to be heard at the last Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee meeting, but since our bill hasn't been presented to Committee yet, I was not able to get a hearing. Fear not! I will continue this pursuit into the next session. As soon as I know which Representatives are appointed to the committee, I will be chasing them down to make sure they know where ABATE stands.

So, my report this month is small (as it will be over the next few months as well), but I am including the press release for anyone to use as you see fit (radio, social media, etc.) and also a copy of Governor Kemp's Proclamation.

Rev Up Safety: Celebrate Motorcycle Awareness Month by Sharing the Road *Motorcyclists' Safety Is Everyone's Safety*

Georgia: May marks the beginning of riding season for many motorcyclists in America. It is also Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. The U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) reminds all motorists that *Motorcyclists' Safety Is Everyone's Safety*. Motorcycle safety is an ongoing responsibility for all road users. By consistently following safe driving and riding practices and sharing them with others, all motorists can help reduce the number of motorcyclist fatalities on America's roads.

Each year motorcyclists are overrepresented in traffic crashes. Two leading contributors to this reality are speed and alcohol impairment. It is important to note that, while in years past, riding was seen as a leisure activity, it is now often a person's main or only mode of transportation. It is essential that riders and drivers both pay critical attention to their driving habits and to each other while out on the roads.

According to NHTSA data, there were 6,218 motorcyclists killed in traffic crashes in 2022, representing 15% of total highway fatalities for that year. Speeding was a major contributing factor for motorcyclist fatalities in 2022, accounting for 35% of all motorcyclist fatalities. More than half (51%) of those fatalities were motorcyclists 21 to 24 years old. Alcohol impairment also played a significant role in motorcycle-involved crash fatalities: Forty-two percent of motorcycle riders who died in single-vehicle crashes in 2022 were alcohol-impaired.

Like seat belts, wearing DOT-compliant motorcycle helmets can save lives and reduce injuries. After three years of declines, helmet use increased from 64.9% in 2021 to 66.5% in 2022. NHTSA data estimates that helmets saved 1,872 motorcyclists' lives in 2017 and that 749 more lives could have been saved if all motorcyclists had worn their helmets.

Vehicle drivers and motorcyclists can help reduce the number of fatalities and injuries on America's roadways by:

- Observing all traffic laws and obeying the speed limit.
- Driving and riding alcohol- and drug-free.
- Avoiding distractions while driving or riding.
- Yielding to motorcyclists especially when drivers are turning at intersections.
- Wearing high-visibility protective gear and DOT-compliant motorcycle helmets while riding. Learn how to identify a safe, DOT-compliant helmet at www.nhtsa.gov/motorcycle-safety/choose-right-motorcycle-helmet.

One other significant step that motorcycle riders can take toward promoting road safety for all motorists is completing a rider education and training course.

- WHEREAS:** The motorcyclists of Georgia are committed to promoting motorcycle safety, education, and awareness programs to the public and to the motorist community of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** By reminding motorists to share the road, we can all do our part to ensure the safety of those who travel on Georgia's roadways; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2025, as MOTORCYCLE AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 4th day of April in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.

H.R. 1566 - The REPAIR Act Right To Equitable And Professional Auto Industry Repair

April 4, 2025

Should you have the choice of where to bring your motorcycle for repairs or to do the work yourself? Should you have access to the parts, tools and service information required to maintain, service and modify your bike? Do you want to control who may access the data from your motorcycle and its use? If you answered yes to these questions, it is time to contact your member of the House of Representatives and ask them to cosponsor H.R. 1566, the "Right to Equitable and Professional Auto Industry Repair Act", known as the "REPAIR Act."

The REPAIR Act ensures that vehicle owners or repair shops can access the information, software or tools needed to work on vehicles. This proposed commonsense law establishes rules regarding vehicle data access and will help preserve consumer choice and a fair marketplace.

A similar bill was introduced during the last session of Congress and cosponsored by 56 Representatives. We need to surpass that number during this session. Help us today!

A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to ensure that tailpipe regulations do not limit the availability of new motor vehicles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Choice in Automobile
5 Retail Sales Act of 2025".

Support H.R. 2165 - The Choice In Automobile Retail Sales (CARS) Act Of 2025

March 19, 2025

Congress is currently on a one-week recess, but before they left town, Rep. Tim Walberg of Michigan introduced the Choice in Automobile Retail Sales (CARS) Act of 2025. This bill is similar to legislation Mr. Walberg introduced in 2023, which was passed by the U.S. House. The Senate failed to move on that bill, so it died at the end of the 118th Congress. U.S. Representatives Russ Fulcher of Idaho, Gus Bilirakis of Florida and Rick Allen of Georgia have joined Mr. Walberg as lead cosponsors for the 2025 bill.

This bill focuses on protecting the internal combustion engine. It does this in two ways. First, the bill prohibits using authority under the Clean Air Act to issue regulations that mandate the use of any specific technology or would limit the availability of new motor vehicles based on the vehicle's engine type. Second, the legislation requires the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to update any regulations that result in the limited availability of new vehicles based on the engine.

This legislation would overturn a 2024 EPA rule, which, if not revoked, would cause about 56% of new vehicles sold between 2030 and 2032 to require electric motors.

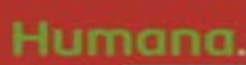

Once in Savannah, numerous tests have been performed and they determined that along with the failed stint, Zac has

Ulcers in his stomach and he is losing blood somewhere, but they are unsure where. Zac is currently in between jobs and has no Health Insurance. His Fiancé is a stay at home Mom to their 2 year old. 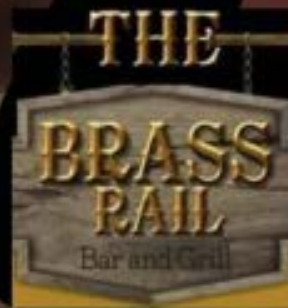

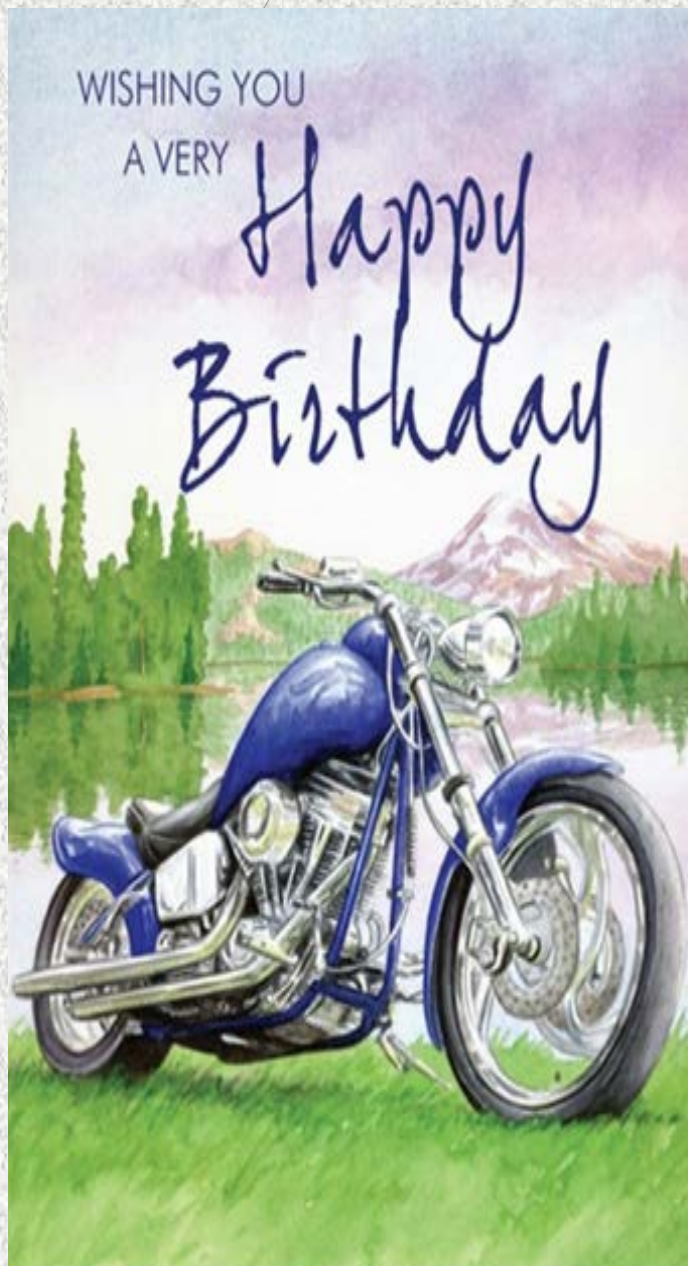

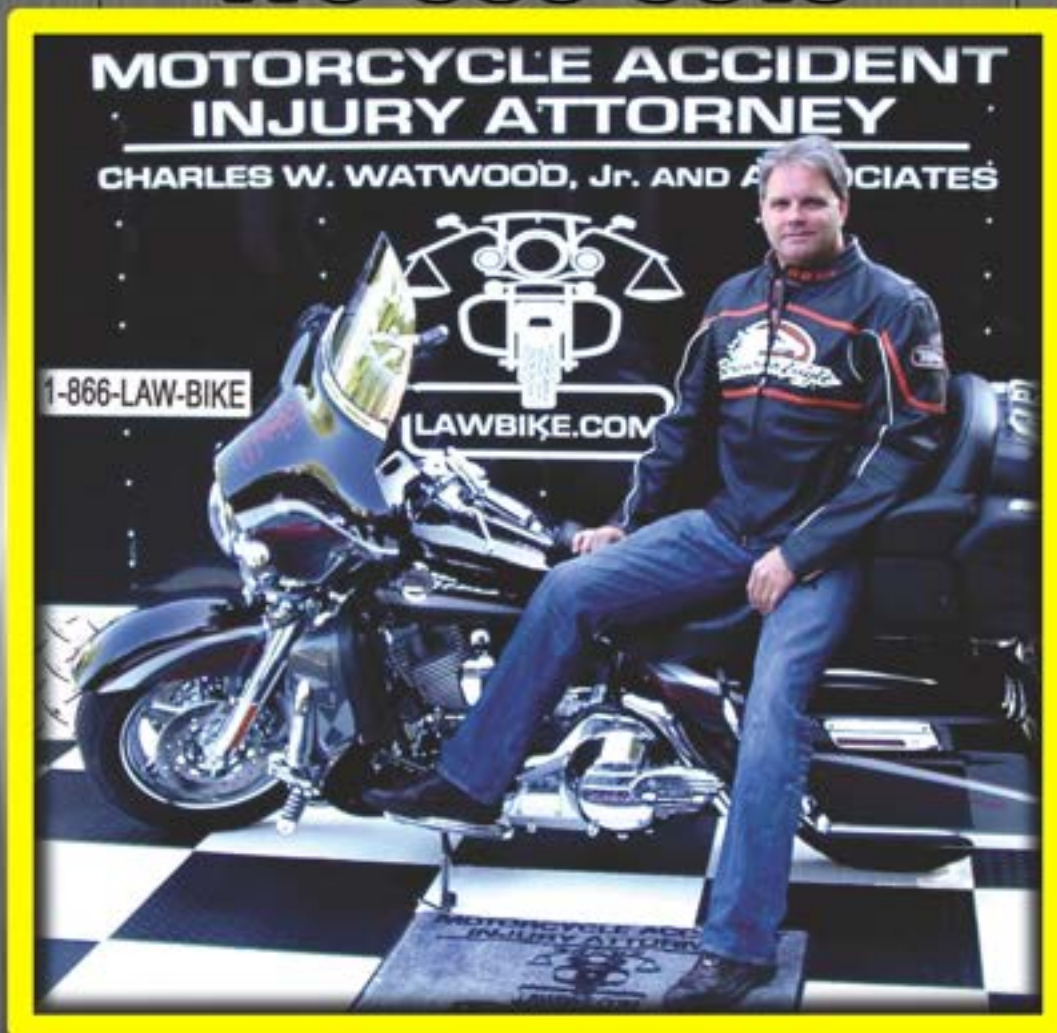
